**OUTSTANDING CONCRETE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD
Presented to Gough, Inc.**

INDIANAPOLIS - The Indiana Ready Mixed Concrete Association (IRMCA) presented the 2005 Outstanding Concrete Achievement Awards for projects in the State of Indiana on December 13, 2005 at the Indianapolis Downtown Marriott.

In the category of **Concrete Commercial & Industrial, Commercial Building Projects**, one of the winning projects was Gough's new office building located in the Merrillville area. Recipients included the following individuals and/or organizations: Gough, Inc., and Ozinga Indiana RMC, Inc.

Gough's goal was to highlight a product that they use, place, and finish everyday. Rather than pour concrete floors and cover them with tile or carpet, their goal was to leave them exposed with a unique finish. Diamond Buffing used a five step process to highlight and finish the floors. The floors were sanded several times using a finer process each time. The floors were then sealed and polished. There was 550 cubic yards of colored concrete used in this project.

IRMCA presents these awards to recognize extensive application or imaginative use of concrete; and to honor the accomplishments of project owners, architects, engineers, contractors, owners and ready mixed concrete producers.
