The Indiana Ready Mixed Concrete Association (IRMCA) assigns the highest priority to full compliance with both the letter and the spirit of the antitrust laws, and it is vital that all meetings be conducted in a manner consistent with this policy. If at any time during the course of this meeting, IRMCA counsel or staff believes that a sensitive topic under the antitrust laws is being discussed, or is about to be discussed, they will so advise the meeting and halt further discussion. As attendees at an IRMCA meeting, you should likewise not hesitate to voice any concerns that you may have in this regard.

It is important to bear in mind that those in attendance at IRMCA meetings may be your competitors. Any discussions of commercial matters with one's competitors may create the appearance of an antitrust violation, even though there is none. Therefore, such discussions should be avoided at all times before, during and after IRMCA meetings.
